Thank you for your inquiry on the upcoming litter of German Wirehaired Pointer pups I have for sale. This litter is the result of breeding my Q's Besser V Grossklaus UT (dam) to Salty Pete V Rahnhaus UT (sire).

The Litter Dam: Bess is a North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association (NAVHDA) Utility (UT) Dog and has also qualified in American Kennel Club (AKC) hunt tests at the Master (highest) level. Her NAVHDA test records are attached. She is from a NAVHDA Breeders Award litter in which three pups, including Bess, achieved perfect scores in Natural Ability Tests. I was allowed pick of the litter.

Bess is a great companion and an outstanding hunting dog, with exceptional natural nose, bird finding, retrieving, desire and stamina abilities. Her nose use and quality are her most outstanding features. Test judges from California to Maine have been impressed and raved about her scenting abilities. Her nickname "The Nose" is well justified. Depending on cover density, her natural range varies from close to moderate, but expands to field trial distances when handled or judged from horseback. Her hips have been OFA evaluated at excellent and good. Her coat is shorter, flat, dense, oily, double layered and liver and white ticked. She has a mostly solid colored head, with full furnishings and is great to look at. She is an excellent mother and is great to look at. An AKC style pedigree on Bess is attached and a complete NAVHDA Registration copy is available by request.

Her dam, Q V Grossklaus, is a NAVHDA Utility Dog of German and American VDD breeding. Her and her ancestral test scores are shown on the attached pedigree. Her ancestors and relatives have demonstrated consistently high scores in VDD and NAVHDA tests. Q is the main reason I purchased Bess from the Grossklaus Kennels. She is one of the best overall hunting dog I have ever observed. Q consistently produced high quality puppies and fortunately passed her hunting abilities on to Bess.

The sire of Bess, AFC/FC BO Taylor Rahnhaus UT was an AKC Field Champion and NAVHDA Utility dog who has also won competitive National Shoot to Retrieve Trials. He is the result of line breeding AKC Field Champions. With several different bitches, his prepotency for pups achieving high NAVHDA scores is amazing.

The Litter Sire: Salty Pete is a NAVHDA UT and received a perfect score in his NA test. His utility scores are attached. He has competed effectively in national shoot to retrieve trials as well. He has a deserved reputation as a as an outstanding water dog. He is a unique combination of NAVHDA, AKC field trial, German, and Mason Creek dogs. His hips tested as one of the tightest in the PennHip database and a copy is attached. His pups have averaged 105 in NAVHDA NA tests and he has sired a breeders award litter.

Purchasing Puppies: The price of puppies is \$500 for males and \$600 for females. Depending on the litter sex ratios and demand, some females may be available at a reduced cost, but with a spay contract rider. The pups will whelp the forth week in March and a \$150 reservation deposit is due by March 1, 1998. This fee is non-refundable, except in the case of puppy unavailability.

The reservation deposit must be accompanied by a preference letter indicating the type of pup you want. Be very specific as to sex, temperament, size, color, and other characteristics you desire. I will try to provide the best pup for you. Please include information of the type of hunting, testing, or trials you most commonly participate in, where the pup will be housed, and what pup transferring arrangement you would like to use. Also a short (less than 12 letters) dog name starting with the letter B is requested for your pup. As a B litter from this kennel the pups registered name must start with B. If you don't decide on a registration name I will assign one and you can "call name" the dog anything you want later.

Receiving of Puppies: Puppies can be viewed and played with anytime after they are five weeks old and are available to their new owner at seven to ten weeks, which will start the third week in May. All pups must be paid for in full by cash, certified check, or money order before they will be released. Personal checks can only be used if given one week in advance of transference.

It is expected the pups will be picked up here at seven weeks old. New owners will be charged extra for pups held beyond eight weeks, unless I decide to hold a limited number of pups for final evaluation. Arrangements can be made for my delivering pups locally or for air shipment to out of area buyers. If air shipped, I can furnish crates, to be returned UPS, and arrange flights out of Salt Lake City to the destination of your choice. Some shipments are COD and others require prepayment. All air shipment or my delivery costs are paid for by the buyer.

All puppies will be vaccinated, tail docked, dew claws removed, wormed if needed, and registered with NAVHDA. Forms will be provided for owners wanting to register with AKC, at their expense. A puppy starting kit will be included.

After Transferring Services and Guarantee: If the owner desires testing of the pup in the NAVHDA system, I will freely provide some literature, consultation, assist with training in the field (if geographically feasible), and reimburse Natural Ability Test entrance fees up to \$65. For a fee I will also prepare and test your pup. I will try and provide answers or refer you to a specialist on any questions you have on German Wirehaired Pointers, training, our litter lineage and progress, other litter availability, breeding, etc.

All puppies are unconditionally guaranteed to be physically sound and contain inherited hunting abilities when released to you.

* * Perfect scores in all high index tests and in all inherited characteristics. She scooped a bird that refused to fly in the test. Steady score lowered overall cooperation and obedience scores. I failed to train for birds that refuse to fly and have to be chased. Only training problems presented a 20%.

* Coat is dense according to other tests. She was UT tested when it was very hot and was just out of her heat cycle, both of which seem to effect density. Harshness of coat is increasing annually.
